I hope that I get the opportunity to bring my experience, expertise and passion to my role as parent representative on the Newborough Primary School Board.



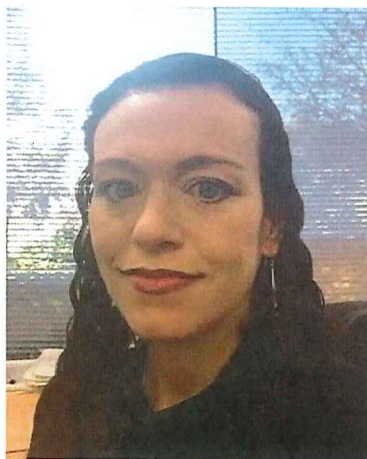
Jemma Gifford
